

Fee Determination

*One-Time Fees

Wait-List Deposit (refundable): \$1000

Service Admission Fee: \$1500

A one-time fee for costs related to admission such as medication review, pharmacy setup, care plan creation with input from family, physicians and other related health professionals.

*Monthly Recurring Fees

There are two elements that go into the total monthly fee. See below:

RENT:

Private Suite - \$3950/month Semi-Private Suite - \$3450/month Executive Private Suite (limited availability) - \$4950/month

CARE PACKAGES:

Before a resident moves in to Trouvaille, our Director of Nursing will do an assessment of the residents' care needs. From this assessment, a care level package (A, B, C, D, E) will be assigned based upon the needs of each individual resident.

Care Package A \$2535/month
Care Package B \$3195/month
Care Package C \$3855/month
Care Package D \$4515/month
Care Package E \$5175/month

Example: \$3950 (rent) + \$3195 (Care Package B) = \$7145/month

Trouvaille has a transparent pricing model so families are aware of the pricing upfront with no hidden costs or expenses.

Rental Fee includes:

- Suite with bathroom, shower and closet
- Three home cooked meals plus snacks (dietician approved)
- Flat screen TV
- Household/personal care items including but not limited to: toothpaste, facial and toilet paper, hand soap, garbage bags, light bulbs, bed and bath linens
- Individual and group activities and outings
- Light housekeeping (garbage emptied and bed made daily)
- Personal laundry services one time per week (up to 2 loads), daily towel and washcloths, bed linens (weekly)
- General maintenance to apartment
- Utilities (including HD cable box in room)
- Wi-Fi internet access
- 24 hour personal pendant system (if desired)

Care Packages include:

- RN on-call 24/7
- Professionally trained care providers available 24/7
- Care providers specially trained on memory loss and managing higher level of care needs
- Nurse consultation with health care professionals as needed
- Ongoing clinical assessment and care plan revisions
- Assistance to meals and activities, including reminders and redirection
- Frequent safety checks
- Assistance with all activities of daily living (ADL's)
- Transfer assistance (1 and 2 person transfers)
- Insulin management
